The participation of women in negotiation processes is one of the key factors in achieving sustainable and just peace, especially in the context of Russia's full-scale armed aggression against Ukraine.

In order to provide the Office of the President of Ukraine with complete, objective, and substantive information, we kindly ask you to specify and provide additional details regarding the potential pool of women experts who are willing to join negotiation processes, indicating their relevant experience, and to identify the specific negotiation processes.
